

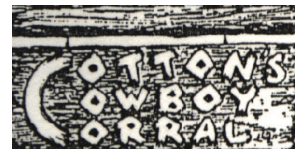

Judging Criteria

The nature of this contest is to select a contestant, who along with appearance, personality and poise must be an accomplished horsewoman. During her reign, she can appear throughout the state participating in parades, grand entries and may also compete for the title of Miss Rodeo California. Information on Miss Rodeo California can be found online at, www.MissRodeoCalifornia.com.

Her image before the public on horseback must be outstanding. The pattern required for horsemanship helps the judges decide which contestant is best suited to represent our area as Marysville Stampede Rodeo Queen.

Please note, the Rodeo Queen Contest judges are not judging the performance of the horse, but the way the contestant keeps the horse under control and how they handle each situation that might occur.

Knowledge and presentation, of answers to rodeo questions, is also of great importance. The Rodeo Queen will promote the sport of rodeo at different functions throughout the year, making this aspect important.

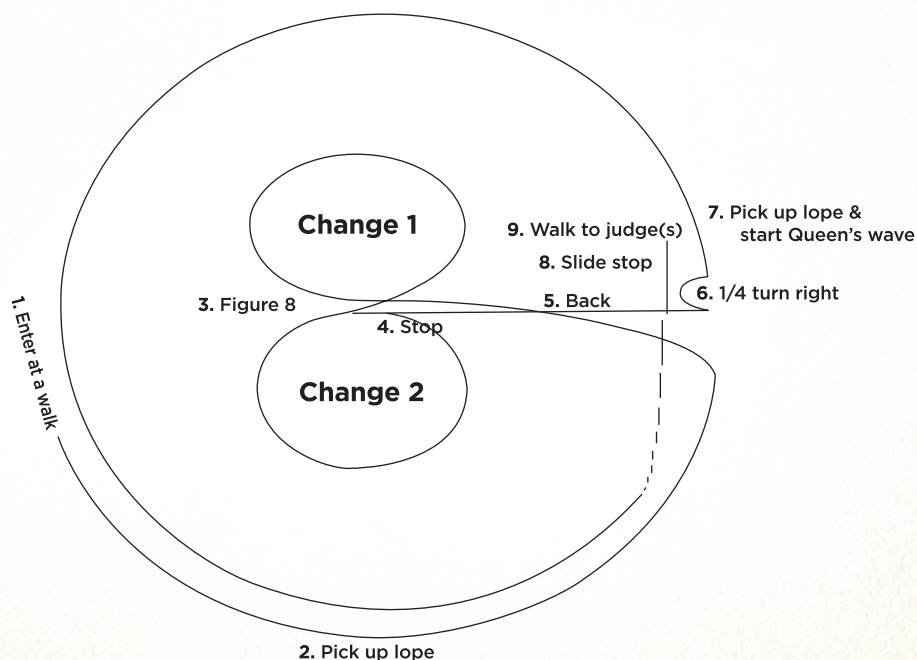

Riding Pattern

1. Enter the arena at a walk going to the right.
2. Pick up the lope (*you should be on your left lead*).
3. Complete one figure eight (*two lead changes*), making your changes in the center of your circles.
4. After you have made your second lead change, close your circle and stop (*you should have made two complete circles*).
5. After your horse has settled, back about 10 to 15 feet. Then stop.
6. Make a quarter turn to your right.
7. Pick up your left lead to start your Queen's Wave. Go around the arena one full time at a controlled fast pace giving your wave.
8. Come to a slide stop at the point where you started your Queen's Wave.
9. Walk your horse over to the judge, dismount and mount again.
10. Once you have mounted, walk your horse out of the arena.

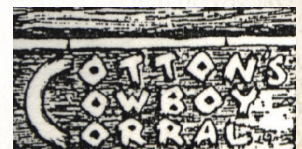
